Scope of Work for Training Partners

- **Program Implementation**
 1. Conduct one-day training programs across multiple locations as per the plan shared by ASDC.
 2. Deliver training sessions aligned with ASDC's standardized curriculum and content (including BS6 and E20 fuel-related updates).
 3. Ensure the participation and training of candidates across specified job roles.
- **Logistics and Infrastructure**
 1. Arrange suitable training venues with necessary infrastructure (classroom facilities, seating, audio-visual aids, and practical demo setups).
 2. Ensure availability of required training equipment such as **OBD scanners, multimeters, and other relevant tools** for hands-on learning.
- **Mobilization of Candidates**
 1. BPCL and ASDC will assist in mobilizing the candidates.
 2. To ensure the registration of candidates on the E-Shram Portal is a must.
 3. ASDC will share candidate data with TPs at least **one week before** uploading it on the **SIDH Portal**.
- **Trainer Deployment**
 1. Deploy qualified trainers certified by ASDC or its authorized bodies.
 2. Ensure uniform and engaging delivery of training content across all sessions.
- **Assessment & Certification**
 1. Facilitate Online/Offline assessments (where applicable) after the completion of the training program.
 2. Coordinate with ASDC and assessment bodies for smooth certification of candidates.
 3. To ensure the distribution of the Certificate once it is generated.
- **Monitoring & Feedback**
 1. Capture candidate attendance, feedback, and learning outcomes from each session.
 2. Submit reports to ASDC in the prescribed format for review and monitoring.
- **Coordination**
 1. Work closely with the ASDC team and regional SPOCs for effective execution.
 2. Maintain continuous communication with ASDC regarding progress, challenges, and best practices.
