i) Evaluation of bids:

The minimum qualifying marks is 80 against maximum marks prescribed 100 and the bidder who scores a minimum of 80 marks in the technical criteria will be shortlisted for opening the financial bid.

The evaluation of the Technical and Financial offers will be based on the QCBS (Quality and Cost Based Selection) with Technical and financial ratio being 80:20 (80 for Technical and 20 for Financial).

The bidders whose technical offers are responsive against the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed with the minimum qualifying marks in each of the above criteria will be shortlisted and commercial bids of such short listed bidders only will be opened and also all compulsory/ mandatory prescribed documents to be uploaded otherwise bid will be rejected summarily.

The Services Receiver will evaluate and compare the TENDERS, which have been determined to be substantially responsive, pursuant to each schedule separately. No TENDER will be considered if the complete requirements covered in the schedule is not included in the TENDER.

1. Training for Minority candidates for generating employment opportunities.
2. Conditional TENDERS are liable for rejection.
3. Intending TENDER bidders can have detailed information from the office during office hours.
4. Managing Director, KMDC, Bengaluru, reserves the right to reject any or all TENDERS without assigning any reason.
5. The selected agency must have attendance system (Bio metric) in the training center and submit attendance to the Managing Director, KMDC Bengaluru.
6. The selected Agency shall provide pre-examination training to the aspirants of Drone Pilot. The training should be given for complete syllabus during the prescribed course period.
7. Residential training will include accommodation, meals and refreshments for the entire duration of the contract. The center and residential area must be located on owned, rented, or leased premises. Both the center and the residential area should have adequate security measures, facilities, and 24/7 CCTV surveillance. Additionally, the residential area must have separate facilities for boys and girls.
8. The selected agency/consortium should not sublet the contract. If the Bidders are found to have sublet the contract, the contract will be terminated at the risk and cost of the agency concerned.
9. The selected Agency shall enter into a contract agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) with terms and conditions as per the format specified by Managing Director, KMDC, Bengaluru, within 07 days from the receipt of written communication of letter of acceptance to this effect failing which the EMD will be forfeited.
10. Course fee will be paid in three installments, as decided by the TENDER acceptance authority, KMDC
11. Training Days :- 15 days as detailed above
12. Bidder should have back office support cell to assist the Department to select the eligible candidates based on eligibility criteria.
13. Bidder should provide training according to prescribed syllabus and Training calendar in consultation with Managing Director, KMDC, and Bengaluru.

14. Course fee quoted by bidder per candidate should include all the expenses to complete the training process.
15. KMDC, Bengaluru will not be in any way directly or vicariously liable for any injury or damage caused to the trainee or personal during the training period.
16. **Penalty clause:** The successful bidder must provide all the resource manpower from the date of starting of training, failing which penalty at the rate of Rs.100/- shall be charged per day per person subject to a maximum of work order value. After which work order will be cancelled. In addition, forfeiture of performance security deposit will also be considered.
17. The Principal Secretary, The Managing Director and the Authorized officer appointed by KMDC, Bengaluru, shall have the power to inspect the center and issue notice in writing and to instruct/direct the agency to make alterations/variations in the assigned work.

18. Evaluation of Technical Bid:

A. Evaluation of Technical Bids -

A TENDER scrutiny committee will be formed by KMDC for evaluation of the bids. The committee would evaluate both Pre-qualification cum Technical bids based on the details provided in the e-TENDER. A presentation has to be submitted along with the technical bid. The bidder scoring the highest mark during the technical and commercial / Financial bid evaluation will be awarded the contract. Decision of the committee would be final and binding upon all the Bidders.

19. For all disputes arising out of this contract between the agency and KMDC, will be within the jurisdiction of the courts in Bengaluru city.

20. Failure to abide by the Agreement:

The conditions stipulated in the agreement shall be strictly adhered to and violation of any of the conditions will entail termination of the contract without prejudice to the rights of the KMDC with such penalties as specified by the Agreement.

21. Confidentiality of the Document:

This TENDER Document is confidential and the KMDC shall ensure that anything contained in this TENDER Document shall not be disclosed in any manner, whatsoever.

22. The successful bidder shall furnish performance security within 15 days from the date of signing the agreement at 5% on contract value in the form of DD drawn in favour of Managing Director, KMDC, Bengaluru or bank guarantee having validity for the entire period of training i.e., from the date of issue of work order. The TENDER inviting authority reserve rights to get the security deposit/Bank guarantee extended for further period based on the extension of the service.
23. Appeal: Any Tenderer aggrieved by an order passed by the TENDER accepting authority may appeal to the prescribed appellate authority within seven days from the date of receipt of such order or rejection/disqualification.

24. Rejection Criteria:

Besides other conditions and terms of the TENDER document, bids may be rejected under following circumstances.

A. Pre-Qualification cum Technical Rejection Criteria.

- Bids submitted without or with improper EMD.
- If the information provided by the Bidder is found to be incorrect / misleading at any stage / time during the TENDERING Process.
- Any effort on the part of a Bidder to influence the bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions.
- Bids without signature of person (s) duly authorized on required pages of the bid.
- Bids without power of authorization and any other document consisting of adequate proof of the ability of the signatory to bind the Bidder.
- Failure to furnish proofs for information provided.
- Bidders shall ensure that documents are scanned and uploaded in the slots specified in e-procurement portal.
- Failure to furnish all information required by the e-TENDER document or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the TENDER document in every respect.
- Bidders not complying with the Technical and General Terms and Conditions as stated in the e-TENDER.
- The Bidder not conforming to unconditional acceptance of full responsibility for providing services in accordance with the Agreements of this TENDER.
