2. All bidders are required to pay bid security fee as per the details mentioned in data sheet.
 - 2.1 The bid security shall be returnable not later than 90 days from the Bid Validity Date except in the case of the Selected Bidder whose Bid Security shall be retained.
 - 2.2 The Authority shall be entitled to forfeit the Bid Security as Damages inter alia in any of the events specified herein below. The Bidder, by submitting its Bid pursuant, shall be deemed to have acknowledged and confirmed that the Authority will suffer loss and damage on account of withdrawal of its Bid or for any other default by the Bidder during the period of Bid validity as specified in this tender, no relaxation of any kind on Bid Security shall be given to any Bidder.
3. The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and conditions in the tender document. Failure to furnish all information required by the tender document or submission of a tender not substantially responsive to the tender document in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

4. Preparation of Bids

Form of Bid: The form of a bid shall be completed in all respects and duly signed and stamped by an authorized representative of the Bidder. Relevant power of attorney for signing the bid should be attached.

- 5.3 TAC shall endeavor to respond to the queries raised or clarifications sought by the Bidders. To be fair to all prospective bidders, the responses to queries shall be uploaded on the website (tntenders.gov.in). However, **TAC** reserves the right not to respond to any query or provide any clarification, in its sole discretion, and nothing in this clause shall be construed, taken or read as compelling or requiring **TAC** to respond to any query or to provide any clarification.
- 5.4 At any time prior to the Bid Due Date, **TAC** may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarifications requested by Bidder(s), modify the tender document by way of issue of Addendum/Corrigendum/Clarifications. Any Addendum/Corrigendum/Clarifications thus issued shall be uploaded on the e-tender website.

6. Pre-Bid Meeting

- 6.1 To clarify and discuss issues with respect to the Project and the tender Document, a pre-Proposal meeting ("Pre-Bid Meeting") will be held on 13-02-2026 at 3.30PM in 3rd floor Commissionerate of Labour, Labour Officers Quarters, P Block, 6th Avenue, Anna Nagar, Chennai – 600040.

- 6.2 Prior to the Pre-Bid meeting, the Bidders may submit a list of queries and proposed suggestions in the word format as per '**Annexure-A**,' if any, to the tender requirements.
- 6.3 Prior to the Pre-Bid meeting, the Bidders may submit a list of queries and proposed suggestions in the word format as per '**Annexure-A**,' if any, to the tender requirements.
- 6.4 Bidders may note that **TAC** will not entertain any deviations to the tender Document at the time of submission of the Proposal or thereafter. The Proposal to be submitted by the Bidders will be unconditional and unqualified, and the Bidders would be deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions of the tender Document with all its contents. Any conditional Proposal shall be regarded as non-responsive and would be liable for rejection.
- 6.5 In case of any change in the schedule of the Pre-Bid Meeting, the same will be communicated to Bidders through the e-tender website.

7. Format and Signing of Bid

- 7.1 The documents comprising the bid shall be typed, and all pages of the bid shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder.
- 7.2 The bid shall contain no alternations, omissions, or additions except those to comply with an instruction issued by **TAC** or are necessary to correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed/signed by the person signing the bid.
- 7.3 The proposal shall be properly bound, indexed, and serially numbered.

8.0 Submission of Bids

- 8.1 The bidder shall submit their offer i.e. Technical Bid and the Financial Bid shall be submitted on the e-tender portal only. The Bids that are submitted beyond the stipulated date and time under any circumstances what so ever will not be considered.

9. Late and Delayed Bids :

- 9.1 Bids must be received no later than the date and time stipulated in the tender document. **TAC** may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids in which case all rights and obligations of **TAC** and the bidder will be the same.
- 9.2 Any bid received by **TAC** after the deadline for submission of bids, as stipulated above, shall not be considered.

10. Opening and Evaluation of Technical Bid

- 10.1 The Technical Bid of the bidder would be evaluated as per the evaluation criteria set out in the tender document. Bids will be evaluated based on the information submitted by the bidders. However, **TAC** reserves the right to seek clarification/documents from the bidders, if **TAC** considers it necessary for proper assessment of the bid.
- 10.2 The Technical Bids will be evaluated based on eligibility criteria and only those Bidders whose Technical Proposals get a score of minimum 50 (fifty) marks out of 100 (one hundred) shall qualify for financial bid opening and shall be ranked from highest to the lowest based on their technical score (St).

11. Opening of Financial Bid and Final Evaluation

- 11.1 The Financial Bids of the technically qualified bidders shall be opened by the committee.
- 11.2 **The selection of the bidder shall be based on the QCBS method in which weightage of the technical score shall be 80% and weightage of the financial score shall be 20%.**
- 11.3 The lowest quoted Financial Proposal (Fm) is given the maximum financial score (Sf) of 100. The financial scores of other Proposals will be computed as follows:

$$Sf = 100 * Fm / F$$

(F = amount of Financial Proposal)

- 11.4 Proposals will finally be ranked according to their combined technical (St) and financial (Sf) scores as follows:
S = St x 80% + Sf x 20%.

11.5 The Bidder having the highest combined score shall be the Successful Bidder.

11.6 Failure of the Successful Bidder to comply with the requirements shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the LOA. In such an event, **TAC** reserves the right to, invite the second-ranked bidder and ask them to match the financial proposal given by the successful bidder upon the following scenario, take any such measure as may be deemed fit in the sole discretion of **TAC**, including annulment of the Bidding Process.

12. Evaluation of Bids

Tender Evaluation committee consisting of officials from Tamil Nadu, Labour Department would examine both the Technical and Financial Bids based on the details provided in invitation for proposal for those training providers who are shortlisted as per the eligibility criteria for technical evaluation.

13. Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all bids

- 13.1 **TAC** is not bound to accept the lowest bid or any bid and may at any time by giving notice in writing terminate the tendering process.
- 13.2 **TAC** may terminate the contract/cancel the LOA if it is found that the bidder is blacklisted on previous occasions by any of the central/state government ministry/directorate/ institutions/ local bodies/ municipalities/ PSUs, etc.
- 13.3 **TAC** may also terminate the contract/cancel the LOA in the event the Successful Bidder fails to furnish the performance security or fails to execute the agreement.

14. Award of Contract

- 14.1 **TAC** will award the contract to the Successful Bidder to perform the contract satisfactorily as per the terms and conditions incorporated in the tender document.
- 14.2 **TAC** will communicate the outcome to the Successful Bidder by mail confirmed by letter transmitted by registered/speed post that its bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the condition of contract

called the "Letter of Award") shall prescribe the amount which **TAC** will pay to the Successful Bidder in consideration of the execution of work/services by them as prescribed in the contract.

- 14.3 The Successful Bidder will be required to commence the assignment at the earliest, as communicated by **TAC** in this regard.
- 14.4 The Successful Bidder will be required to start execute the contract for the services within a period of Seven days from the date of issue of Work order.

15. Performance Security

The Successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security prior to sign the contract (for an amount which is 3 % of first tranche amount) in the form of Bank Guarantee from a scheduled Bank in an acceptable form in favor of (Commissioner of Labour, Tamil Nadu Academy of Construction, Chengalpattu-603103) the Performance Security shall be valid for a period (which will be fixed later) beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations. In case the contract period is extended, further, the validity of Performance Security shall also be extended by the Successful Bidder accordingly. The format for BG for Bid Security is provided at **Annexure-VII**.

16. Penalty

- 16.1 In case the Bidder fails to deploy the proposed resources considered for evaluation in the bid, **TAC** reserves the right to reduce remuneration of that resource by 10% of the remuneration which would have been paid to the original personnel, till completion of contract.
- 16.2 In case the Service Provider/resource deployed fails to commence/execute the work as assigned to them/unsatisfactory performance of the resource even after formal warning, **TAC** reserves the right to impose the penalty at 0.50% of the monthly billable value of the firm per such incidents as approved by the competent authority.
- 16.3 No Penalty will be imposed for delay attributable to **TAC** or reasons which fall within the definition of Force Majeure as per this tender document.

17. FAIRNESS AND GOOD FAITH

17.1 Good Faith: The Parties undertake to act in good faith with respect to each other's rights under this Contract and to adopt all reasonable measures to ensure the realization of the objectives of this Contract.

17.2 Operation of the Contract: The Parties recognize that it is impractical in this Contract to provide for every contingency which may arise during the life of the Contract, and the Parties hereby agree that it is their intention that this Contract shall operate fairly as between them, and without detriment to the interest of either of them, and that, if during the term of this Contract either Party believes that this Contract is operating unfairly, the Parties will use their best efforts to agree on such action as may be necessary to remove the cause or causes of such unfairness, but no failure to agree on any action pursuant to this Clause shall give rise to a dispute subject to arbitration in accordance with Clause GC 8 hereof.

18. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

All disputes and difference between the parties in connection with the contract or its interpretations, shall be settled amicable manner with best efforts. Beyond the efforts the disputes would be governed by and construed in accordance with, the laws of India and Courts at Chennai.

19. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES AND PENALTIES

- 19.1 The Training Provider hereby agrees that due to negligence of act of the Training Provider, if the "Department" suffers losses, damages the quantification of which may be difficult, and hence the amount specified hereunder shall be construed as reasonable estimate of the damages and Training Provider agrees to pay such liquidated damages, as defined hereunder as per the provisions of this Contract.
- 19.2 The number of liquidated damages under this Contract shall not exceed 10% of the total value of the contract as specified in Appendix D.
- 19.3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, in no event shall either Party be liable, whether in contract or in otherwise for special, punitive, indirect or consequential damages, including without limitation, loss

of profits or revenue arising under or in connection with this Agreement.

20. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:

- (i) Nothing contained in this Contract shall be construed as establishing or creating between the Parties, a relationship of master and servant or principal and agent.
- (ii) The Training Provider shall notify the Department/the Government of Tamil Nadu of any material change in their status, in particular, where such change would impact on performance of obligations under this Contract.
- (iii) Each member/constituent of the Training Provider, shall be severally liable to and responsible for all obligations towards the Department/Government for performance of works/services including that of its Associates/Sub Contractors under the Contract.
- (iv) The Training Provider shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Department/Government of Tamil Nadu against all claims/ damages etc. for any infringement of any Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) while providing its services under the Project.
- (v) The Training Provider shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Department/Government of Tamil Nadu against any claims in respect of any damages or compensation payable in consequences of any accident or injury sustained or suffered by its (the Training Provider) employees or agents or by any other third Party resulting from or by any action, omission or operation conducted by or on behalf of the Training Provider.
- (vi) The Training Provider shall at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Department/Government of Tamil Nadu against any and all claims by Employees, Workman, Contractors, sub-contractors, suppliers, agent(s), employed engaged or otherwise working for the Training Provider , in respect of wages, salaries, remuneration, compensation or the like.
- (vii) All claims regarding indemnity shall survive the termination or expiry of the Contract.
- (viii) It is acknowledged and agreed by all Parties that there is no representation of any type, implied or otherwise, of any absorption, regularization,

continued engagement or concession or preference for employment of persons engaged by the (Training Provider) for any engagement, service or employment in any capacity in any office or establishment of the Government of Tamil Nadu or the Employer.

D. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Bidders must read carefully the conditions of eligibility (the "Conditions of Eligibility") provided herein. Proposals of only those Bidders who satisfy the Conditions of Eligibility will be considered for evaluation. Consortium bids are not permitted. Only individual bidder participation is accepted. PSU participation is permitted provided subcontracting is strictly prohibited. Violation shall result in immediate backlisting. To be eligible for evaluation of its Proposal, the Bidder shall fulfill the following Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

F. TERMS OF REFERENCE

Scope of Work

Director of Tamil Nadu Academy of Construction (hereinafter referred as TAC) has proposed to identify Training Provider (TP) **to provide Online skill up- gradation training in 40 skill courses to 50,000 Higher Education studied and now Studying Children of construction workers registered with Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board (TNCWWB)** to develop a skillful youth workforce.

About the Program

(A) The Tamil Nadu academy of Construction (TAC) aims to provide additional skills to the Children of registered construction workers through online skill training Program considering the opportunities for better employment in the digital era, which is presently facing a huge dearth of skilled manpower. It is also designed to prepare the students to become entrepreneurs in any sector.

(B) The applicant agencies need to broadly adhere to relevant guidelines of online skill training programs as lay down by TAC from time to time.

Details of the Assignment

As per the emphasizing future skills and Industry 4.0 standards, the Government of TAC aims to transform skill training delivery for registered construction workers and their dependents across all educational levels—including Secondary (10th), Senior Secondary (12th), ITI, Diploma, and Degree programs.

The TAC has conducted comprehensive research on application-based learning methodologies and is committed to enhancing knowledge and skill development for all workers and dependents to foster a deeper understanding of contemporary concepts. Historical educational approaches have created substantial gaps between industry requirements and classroom instruction,

resulting in critical challenges:

Skill Gap and Unemployment: The disparity between industry-required competencies and delivered education has created a significant skill gap, contributing to unemployment—one of India's most pressing challenges.

Limited Guidance and Resources: Students face limited resources and guidance when navigating diverse educational pathways. Construction worker dependents, in particular, require a comprehensive platform offering integrated knowledge, guidance, and practical exposure.

To address these challenges, TAC has implemented a Welfare Scheme providing comprehensive skill training to the dependents of registered construction workers through an online learning platform, enabling skill upgradation regardless of geographic location.

The online training platform is designed to be device-agnostic and accessible 24/7 from any internet-connected device. The curriculum is delivered through high-definition video lectures, enabling learners to progress at their own pace without requiring geographic relocation. This approach substantially benefits rural users by reducing travel time and associated costs.

(A) Program Objectives
