#### 1. Overview of NSTFDC:

National Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC) is incorporated as a Govt. Company under the Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) and granted license under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 (now Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013). It is managed by the Board of Directors having representation from Central Govt., State Channelizing Agencies, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI) Tribal Co-operative Marketing Development Federation of India Ltd. (TRIFED) and eminent persons representing Scheduled Tribes.

The Corporation plays a leading role in the economic up-liftment of Scheduled Tribes by providing them financial assistance at concessional rates of interest through channelizing agencies for setting up viable income generating project. Financial assistance of NSTFDC is available to only those Scheduled Tribes having annual family income of up to Rs. 3,00,000/- p.a. residing both in rural and urban areas.

## 2. Scope of Work:

The implementation Agency (IA) selected will execute CSR funded projects for NSTFDC. These projects will be funded to NSTFDC by CSR donor companies as a part of their mandatory CSR activities. NSTFDC aims to undertake projects to enhance the quality of education by interventions in terms of infrastructure building and capacity building of students and teachers of Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) run by National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) across 26 states and UTs. The interventions to focus on education and health sector.

EMRS schools are residential schools established and run by National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), a society under Ministry of Tribal Affairs across 26 states and UTs. NSTFDC aims to enhance the learning environment of these EMRS schools and hostels by providing better access to quality health, education and infrastructure for the tribal students studying. These interventions will ensure overall wellbeing of children leading to enhanced learning outcomes.

#### **Broad Scope of Work includes:**

- i. To prepare DPR in consultation with NSTFDC to be submitted to the Donor Organisation/PSUs.
- To ensure quality and sustainability while implementing the projects in as per mutually agreed time frame along with its monitoring and reporting to NSTFDC;
- iii. To deliver and execute project objectives which shall include- availability of goods & services; documentation and report writing, submission of utilization receipts/ certificates, videos, photographs; promoting and branding; providing AMC services and any such other requirement(s) in the projects as required by donor agency;
- iv. To ensure fulfilment of all documentary requirements as prescribed under the Companies Act and relevant Rules and also by donor agencies;
- v. To support NSTFDC in reaching out to more CSR donors to meet the cause of tribal people; and
- vi. Ensuring publicity/branding in each project to the satisfaction of the donor agencies, which will include creation of short videos, coffee table books, promotional contents etc.

#### 6. Instructions for Submission of Tender:

The EOI/tender document is required to be submitted in three separate sealed envelopes; the Pre-Qualification, Technical & Financial Bids are to be placed in 3 different sealed envelopes and super-scribed "Pre-Qualification Bid", "Technical Bid" & "Financial Bid". All these envelopes may be placed in a larger envelope duly super-scribing as "Bid for hiring of implementation agency for execution of CSR projects", which will be opened on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 11.30 hrs in conference room of NSTFDC office.

Bids received without three separate envelopes shall be rejected and will not be considered further. The envelope containing the proposal may be sent by Registered Post/ Courier or dropped in the "Tender Box" placed at Regd. Office of NSTFDC and addressed to Ms. Bismita Das, Chief Manager (Proj. & CSR).

Bids will only be opened if a minimum of 3 bids received or else tendering process will be cancelled and bids will be returned.

**7. Selection process:** The Technical Bids of only those bidders will be opened who meet the pre-qualification criteria. The selection will be based on Two Stage QCBS method and the work will be awarded to bidder with the Highest Composite Score.

## 8. Pre-Qualification Eligibility Criteria

a. The Agency should be a registered legal entity with at least 5 years standing up to the date of issue of tender notice. (Please attach copy of incorporation/registration).

- b. The Agency should have carried out projects for minimum three Government Agency/ Deptt./ Public Sector Undertaking/ Autonomous Body/ Academic Institutions of national importance, in the last five financial years; wherein at least one such project should be funded and executed in development sector/ CSR intervention in training, capacity building, infrastructure support and /or environment or any other development sector, in multiple states. (Please attach the list of credentials and clientele along with their work orders).
- c. The Agency should not have been blacklisted during last 3 years by any Department of Government of India or Public Sector Undertaking or any other Govt. Organization. (Please attach an affidavit of this effect signed by the authorized legal representative of the Agency).
- d. The Agency should be registered with the GST authority as applicable.
- e. The Agency should furnish last 3 financial years audited financial statement (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25). The average turnover during the last three years of the Agency (Tenderer) should be more than Rs.10 crores. (Please attach CA certificate).

#### 9. Reasons of rejection:

The proposal will be summarily rejected in case of any of the following;

- The proposal received after the stipulated date and time.
- Open / Stapled / improperly sealed proposal or no separate envelopes for Technical & Financial bids or received through fax/mail.
- The proposal received without EMD & Bid processing fees (unless exempted).
- > The agency is registered for less than 5 years.
- Conditional Bid submitted by the agency.
- The agency has been blacklisted during last 3 years.

#### 10. Selection Process

## **Step 1: Pre-Qualification of Technical Bid:**

The Technical Bid of only those Agencies shall be considered that fulfill all the prequalification eligibility criteria and provide required supporting documents including the **EMD** and **Bid processing fees of Rs. 2360/- (exempted for MSE).** The EMD shall be refunded to unsuccessful bidders without interest within three months from the date of opening of Tender (**Financial Bid).** The EMD of the successful bidder (not exempted under MSE provisions) shall be considered as a part of the Performance Security, as specified in Annexure 4, Point 3. In such case, the bidder will be required to submit the balance amount of the Performance Security accordingly.

#### **Step 2: Pre-Bid Meeting:**

The Pre-Bid meeting may be held on **18**<sup>th</sup> **November 2025 at 15.30 hrs,** if there is any change in the date it will be uploaded on the web portal of NSTFDC.

### **Step 3: Evaluation of Technical Bid:**

The Technical Bid shall be opened on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 11.30 hrs. by a Bid opening committee constituted by NSTFDC for the purpose in presence of the representatives of agencies, who wished to be present during opening of the Bids. The Technical Bids shall be evaluated by the Tender Evaluation Committee. Such committee at its discretion may visit Agencies' office/work place to check infrastructure/relevant documents as available with the Agency. The technical bid will be evaluated as per the criteria specified in this document.

## **Step 4: Evaluation of Financial Bid:**

The Financial Bids of only those Agencies shall be opened that have secured minimum 70 marks in technical bid. The date and time for opening of Financial Bid will be intimated to the successful bidder in technical bid, who can send their representative on the day of opening of financial bid. The selection will be based on Two Stage QCBS method and the work will be awarded to bidder with the Highest Composite Score.

### **Financial Score:**

The financial score of the bidder will be calculated with respect to the lowest quote shown against the cost of implementation of the project by any bidder. The lowest cost will be considered as the percentage of the total value of project claimed by the bidder as the cost of implementation and also based on the maximum price shown against each item of goods and services.

#### **Step 5: Final Score:**

- a) The Technical bid shall have a weightage of 70% in the overall evaluation of the bid and the financial bid shall have a weightage of 30% in the overall evaluation. The final score of the bidder shall be 0.7 x (Technical Score) + 0.3 x (Financial Score).
- b) The bidder with the highest final score shall be eligible for award of the contract.

- 3. Payment terms and conditions:

The above-mentioned fund release will be subject to the following conditions:

- i. The above payment schedule is subject to the actual release by the CSR funding agency to NSTFDC for each particular project.
- ii. Performance Security: The successful bidder, on award of each project will submit a Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit receipt from a commercial bank/ Bank Guarantee from a commercial bank, equivalent to 5% of the value of each project separately, initially valid for 1 year which may extend based on progress of the project as decided by NSTFDC.
- 4. Upon completion of the project, the bidder is required to submit all documents including relevant invoices, necessary reports, promotional material and other information/ documents to respective CSR donors etc.
- 5. Deliverables and execution of the project broadly include goods and services, various report, utilization certificate, videos, photographs, branding, AMC and such other requirement in the projects concerned.
- 6. These terms and conditions will be applicable for each CSR funded project separately (payment received and work done in any one project cannot be clubbed with another project).

- 7. Agencies not carrying out the work assigned as per the guidelines shall be warned to complete the work as per the specification. In case the agency still does not comply with the instructions, the work order will be cancelled and any amount paid as advance will be recovered along with interest at 9 % p.a. Further, the agency could be blacklisted and no correspondence, in this regard shall be entertained.
- 8. All documents attached with the Tender form should be signed and stamped by an authorized signatory of the Agency.
- 9. It is presumed that the agencies submitting the tender have read and fully understood all the terms and conditions and instructions contained in the Tender Document. No enquiry, verbal or written, shall be entertained in respect of acceptance/rejection of the Tender till the finalization of the Tender.
- 10. Any act on the part of the Agency to influence anybody in the Corporation shall be liable for rejection of the Tender.

- 14. The scope of work can be expanded to other relevant fields/sectors through mutual understanding between NSTFDC and the selected agency. The validity of contract can also be extended on mutually agreeable terms.
- 15. In case of any dispute, the decision of Chairman cum Managing Director of NSTFDC shall be final and binding. Any dispute arising out of this agreement which cannot be amicably settled shall be referred to the sole arbitrator to be appointed by the CMD, NSTFDC and the arbitration would be governed with the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The place of arbitration shall be at New Delhi. Further any dispute between CPSE and Govt. Dept/ Organization shall be governed under AMRCD guideline of Department of Public Enterprises. The Delhi Courts shall have the sole and exclusive jurisdiction to decide the issue of any dispute.

If at any stage it is found that the firm had not carried out actual implementation of respective projects or submitted false/forged documents/information/ photographs to NSTFDC, the organization will be black listed and liable to refund the amount released by NSTFDC with 9 % interest per annum.
