Background: Rajasthan Skill and Livelihoods Development Corporation (RSLDC) is mandated to implement the short-term skill development programmes in the State. The unorganized sector is facing number of challenges with respect to skill development. Facilities for training in informal sector are grossly inadequate. To meet this kind of inadequacy, RSLDC has already issued EOIs earlier to invite proposals for setting up Skill Development Centres (SDCs) and is implementing state sponsored skill training programmes in collaboration with large number of training partners. RSLDC is constantly embracing effective measures to enable easy access to training and skill development to the youth across the State. In order to accelerate this initiative, RSLDC is inviting this EOI from eligible national agencies and business houses, industry bodies, Registered Society/Trust/Association, Government institutions/ Public Sector Units/Universities/Higher educational institutes including technical and professional institutes, colleges, private ITIs, polytechnics and other skill training provider institutions to partner with RSLDC as a training provider to execute skill competency based Vocational Courses under MMKVY (Cat.: III- SAMARTH-कौशल से आत्मनिर्भर) scheme.

MMKVY (Cat.: III- SAMARTH-कौशल से आत्मनिर्भर) scheme is prepared with aim to benefit the marginalized and disadvantage section of society (PSA, Jail Inmates, Nari Niketan, Kishor Grah/Balika Grah, Orphan Home, Transgender, Single Woman/widow/Abandoned, Minority, Blind and Disadvantage sections like Sansi, Bedia, Nut, Kanjar, Lohar, Gumantu/ArdhGumantu, Sahariya, Garasia, Dumor, Kethodi, liquor makers, Baggers, Cleaners, Retired Army man, Farmers etc.) by providing them skill training with employability of self or entrepreneurship.

Invitation

RSLDC now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from eligible national agencies and business houses, industry bodies, Registered Society/Trust/Association, Government institutions/ Public Sector Units/Universities/Higher educational institutes including technical and professional institutes, colleges, private ITIs, polytechnics and other skill training provider institutions, with keen interest to operate, maintain and manage MMKVY (Cat.: III- SAMARTH-कौशल से आत्मनिर्भर) scheme at Rajasthan, and in imparting industry relevant skills. Interested agencies with required qualification and experience may submit their EOI applications as per the prescribed format attached under Annexures of this document, along with details and supporting documents as specified therein.

Objective of EOI

To boost employment and uplift the people of the state, the Rajasthan Skill and Livelihoods Development Corporation (RSLDC) has initiated MMKVY (Cat.: III- SAMARTH-कौशल से आत्मनिर्भर) scheme that

is a short term livelihoods based skill training programme formulated with the aim to benefit Interested youth/woman of Rajasthan having keen to start their own work/business/enterprise as an individual or in group by getting proper skill training. The main objective of this EoI is to:

- To attract proposals from professional skill training provider to organize short term skill training programme and to empanel them as Training Provider.
- Enhance an individual's employability to adapt to changing technologies and labour market demands.
- Improve productivity and living standards of the people.
- Providing skill training with employability of self or entrepreneurship.

Eligibility Criteria

Following will be the eligibility criteria for applicant organization: -

Details of minimum 01 skill development training centres located in the State/UT of India, which are functional/ operational for more than 02 years on the date of application as per Annexure-4.</p> <p>ii. One-time capacity of the training centre should not be less than 90 candidates</p> <p>iii. Details of youths trained not less than 300 in last three (3) years (2019-20, 2020-21, and 2021-22) as per Annexure-5.</p>

For agencies not presently working in Skill Development Domain: Rs. 50 Lakh (50 Lakh) or more from other business activities and positive net worth of, in the past three consecutive financial years (2019-20, 2020-21, and 2021-22).

3. All Agencies are required to submit copy of **audited financial statements (turnover and net worth)** for the last three financial years (as described at 2 (b)) and details as per **Annexure-3B**.
4. Joint Ventures (JV)/ Special Purpose Vehicles (SPV) are also permitted to apply. At least one of the members of the JV/SPV should be able to meet the financial eligibility independently. The terms & condition of JV/SPV is as per **Annexure-8**.
5. Government institutions shall be exempted from all eligibility criteria. They shall however have to submit their fields of expertise in which they wish to conduct training and placements.
6. Should not have been blacklisted by any donor agency/ State Government/ Central Government. A self-certificate must be submitted as per **Annexure-6**.
7. The applicant/agency must read the **MMKVY (Cat.: III-SAMARTH-कौशल से आत्मनिर्भर)** guidelines and circulars issued by RSLDC (as amended from time to time) before filling the proposal. The applicants **are required to provide self-declaration** for the following:
 - I. To arrange sufficient space, furniture, equipment, tools, training aids, raw material, electricity, water supply and other essentials required for imparting training to youth in the proposed course(s).
 - II. To mobilize and counsel youth for training and taking up self-employment after training.
 - III. To hire/engage competent and eligible trainer(s) to undertake training in the proposed courses.
 - IV. To install IRIS Based attendance system for daily attendance (in & out) at the SDC and Hostel, if applicable, which has to be integrated with ISMS system of RSLDC and provide other information required by RSLDC (Exempted in case of Jail/Juvenile/Nari Niketan).
 - V. To arrange assessment and certification of trained youth through external assessor appointed by Project Implementation Agency (PIA).
 - VI. To maintain records of training including the expenditure made for setting up and conduct of skill training programmes for 03 years.
 - VII. To install IP Camera at SDC and provide live feed to Kaushal Darpan established at RSLDC HQ.
 - VIII. To appoint trainers as per guideline provisions in all SDCs.
