A. Information & instructions to the bidders:

1. Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and acquaint themselves before submitting their bids. They should be aware about site conditions, accessibility to the site, availability of construction material, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their working/ Bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not. No extra charges consequent to any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. JKSPDC accepts no liability for lack of any information or its effect on the cost of the works to the Bidder.
2. All costs incurred by the Bidder in connection with, or costs arising out of the preparation of his bid shall be borne by the Bidder, JKSPDC in no case, shall be responsible or liable for any such costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
3. All information required shall be furnished in English.
4. Rates quoted by the bidder shall be for complete job inclusive of carriage, applicable taxes, duties, levies, royalties, Cess etc.
5. In case of any typographical error in nomenclature of an item, the same shall be corrected and paid as per JKSSR 2022 without any price appreciation.
6. The item to be purchased should be of good quality ISI mark.
7. The items to be purchased should be of specified brand with configuration as per laid down in BOQ
8. No price variation of any sort shall be paid whatsoever. The rates quoted shall be fixed for entire period of contract including any extension thereof.
9. In case of death or injury of any labor or any third party at the site of work, the contractor shall have to pay compensation to the injured or the next to the kins of dead as per the prevailing laws and labour norms.
10. Bidders are encouraged to contact JKSPDC for any clarifications and further information by or before the date specified in the e-NIT. JKSPDC shall attempt to provide the relevant information to the extent available with it subjected to the condition that providing such information is necessary prior to bid submission date.
11. The bidders are required to state their address fully including their e-mail ID correctly in their tenders. All notices, communications and references shall be sent through registered Indian post or through courier services and e-mail & shall be deemed as having been delivered within 07 days from the date of issue of these notices.
12. JKSPDC may under the provisions of the contract extend the time of completion of the work or part thereof by such period as he may consider reasonable. The decision of competent authority of JKSPDC shall be final.
13. JKSPDC reserves the right to reject all or any of the e-NIT or any subsequent bids without assigning any reason thereof and shall not be bound to accept the lowest or any other Bid or to give any reason for such decision.
14. Date of Start of the work shall be reckoned from 07 days after date of issuance of Lol/ Allotment Order, whichever is earlier.
15. The bidder declared as L1 after opening of bids shall be required to furnish Performance Security in the form of CDR/FDR/ in favour of **Executive Engineer CMD SVP Kangan @ 3%** of the advertised cost for the works amounting less than 5.00 lacs and for the works greater than 5.00 lacs performance security shall be pledged to accounts Officer within 03 days after being declared as L1. Performance Security furnished by the bidder shall be valid for a period of 06 months beyond the completion period of the work. If the same is e-NIT for the work.

- Demand Draft, same shall be payable at **JK Bank Kangan**. Performance security shall be released after expiry of the defective liability period.
16. The successful bidder shall be required to sign the contract agreement with the JKSPDC within 07 days from submission of the performance security.
 17. Delay in completion of the work beyond the specified Time for Completion would attract penalty/ liquidated damages @ 0.5 % of the contract price per week of delay subject to a ceiling of 10 % (ten percent) of contract price.
 18. Defect liability period for the works within the scope of this contract agreement shall be 06 months from the date of completion of work certified by the Engineer-in-Charge.
 19. In case of contractor fails to start the work within 07 days from date of issuance of LOI/Allotment, whichever is earlier, even after the site is made available for execution of work, a notice shall be sent to the contractor for non-start of the work through registered post/ courier/ email. In case the work is not started within 07 days from the date of issuance of notice, contract shall stand terminated and the work put to fresh tenders. Further, JKSPDC may blacklist the said contractor for two years.
 20. The contractor shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facility for workers and all other services required for executing the work.
 21. The contractor shall have the sole responsibility for supervision of the work and of all workmen engaged therein. He shall be personally responsible for any causality/eventuality, accident during the contract period or any extension thereof and any claim arising due to such eventualities.
 22. Any loss or damage to work due to natural calamity or any other reason during execution of work shall be borne by the Contractor.
 23. Any loss or damage caused to the Govt/Public/private /property by the contractor or his men during execution of the works shall be borne by the Contractor. Quantum of loss/damage shall be assessed by Engineer-in-Charge.
 24. Award of contract shall not authorize the contractor to trespass upon or injure any Govt. or private property or to transgress any of the laws or orders of J&K Government or of the local authorities.
 25. All material taken out of the site of the work is, and shall be, the property of the JKSPDC and the full value of any material, tools and plant belonging to JKSPDC, which may be injured, lost, destroyed or unlawfully removed by the contractor or his employees, will be deducted from the amount due, or that may become due to the contractor.
 26. No Power of attorney shall be entertained /accepted from the Contractor for sub-letting of entire or part of the work.
 27. The contractor is required at all times and all cases to obey and carry out the instructions of the Engineer-in-Charge of the work so far as they are not contrary to anything contained in the contract agreement.
 28. The contractor or his authorized agent is required to remain constantly present at site of the work. No one will be recognized as the contractor's agent at site unless the contractor proposes to the Engineer-in-charge in writing for such appointment.
 29. Any order that the contractor may subsequently receive in writing from any employee of JKSPDC other than Executive Engineer/ Assistant Executive Engineer shall not be considered valid and if the contractor attends to such order it will be entirely at his own risk. Further, no claim for payment for any alteration made by the contractor without written orders from the Executive Engineer shall be entertained.
 30. The quantities of various items of the work given in the tender document may increase or decrease with the approval from competent authority as per the delegation of powers of JKSPDC. The variation in quantities of items of work to be executed shall not be a ground for any claim for compensation or for any variation in rates. The rates to be paid for or give rise to any claim for compensation shall be deemed to be within the scope of the contract and shall be

31. Any item of work needed to be executed at site (other than advertised/ allotted) with the approval from competent authority as per the delegation of powers) shall be paid on JKSSR 2022 rates. In case any such item is not covered under JKSSR 2022, same shall be paid on analyzed rates based on prevalent market rates in the vicinity and approved by the Executive Engineer and same shall be binding on the Contractor.
32. All the works shall have to be executed as per the directions of Engineer-in-Charge and shall conform to the standards as specified in relevant IS Codes. Further, approved brand of cement in J&K shall be used and Steel from SAIL / TATA or equivalent brand shall be used for the work.
33. Contractor shall be bound to rectify defective works as per the directions of Engineer-in-Charge. Defective work shall not be accepted. In case the contractor is reluctant or denies rectifying the same, no payment for the said items shall be made to the contractor.
34. In the event of the execution of under specified work, or use of substandard material being supplied and used by the contractor. The Divisional officer may with sanction of the Chief Engineer engage other agency either to assist contractor or to set right the work as per the applied codal specifications at the risk and cost of the contractor.
35. The Engineer-in-Charge may from time to time, by directions in writing without invalidating the contract in any way, order the contractor to suspend the work or any part thereof for a reason as he may consider necessary and contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation on this account. However, this period shall not extend beyond 03 months from the scheduled days of completion of the work.
36. If the suspension of work is due to any force majeure, Contractor shall be bound to execute the work at the same rates, terms and conditions as per the approved codal specifications at the risk and cost of the Contractor. Payments on this account whatsoever, however extension of time shall be granted for corresponding work suspension period, without imposing any penalty for such period.
37. No claim will be entertained on account of dewatering / pumping / maintenance of service roads, diversion of irrigation khuls/ etc if not otherwise specifically mentioned in the BOQ.
38. The dismantled, usable/ un-usable material (counted/ marked), spared out of this work shall be returned to Divisional stores duly authenticated by the concerned AEE.
39. JKSPDC shall reserve the right to recover any amount from bills/ invoices due to the contractor for settling an unpaid labor claim, if found genuine.
40. In case of any dispute regarding the rates or interpretation of any condition of the contract, decision of Chief Engineer CI&D Wing Kashmir shall be final and binding upon the Contractor.
41. All taxes, duties, levies, Cess etc in vogue during the contract period shall be deducted at source from the bills of the contractor.
42. Contractor shall maintain cement account at site, showing cement received with details of invoices, etc., quantity used daily and progressive consumption and balance at site. Damaged/expired cement will not be allowed to be used in work.
43. The Contractor shall deposit royalty and obtain necessary permit for supply of the earth, Sand, coarse aggregates (bajri), stone, kanker, etc., from respective authorities.
44. Sand used shall be hard durable, clean & free from adherent coating.
45. Before starting the work The Contractor shall, , arrange to test materials such as Steel, Sand, Cement and Bajri, Concrete Cube Test and / or portions of the work at site in any laboratory at his own cost in accordance with the relevant specifications and BIS code of practice. The Contractor shall transport all the materials from the site to the approved laboratory at his own cost. The contractor shall carryout all the mandatory tests as per BIS relevant codes at the frequencies stated therein/ as and when directed by the Employer. Even after such tests, any materials brought to site of the contractor shall be tested for defective or unsound or not as per approved samples, the contractor shall bear the cost of the test at his own cost and without any additional time period, with reference to the test results.

46. Any item if found not necessary at site during execution of work though advertised can be deleted and no claim what so ever shall be entertained on this account.
47. The watch and ward of all Material/Machinery shall be the responsibility of Contractor /Agency.
48. The lowest bidder i.e L1 has to deposit additional performance security in in case of low bid offer as reflected in Condition K of the tender document.

B. Mode of selection of the contractor: Least Cost System (LCS) shall be adopted for selection of successful bidder. The bidder shall be required to quote a percentage rebate to the estimated rates for items listed in the BoQ. The percentage rebate quoted shall form basis for fixing rates in the allotment order.

C. Minimum requisite eligibility for bidders:

1. The bidder should be registered with PWD/PDC/CPWD/MES as contractor of relevant class as mentioned in the e-NIT for the work and the Registration Card must be uploaded on JKPWDOMS PORTAL.
2. The bidder should not be black listed or barred from bidding by JKSPDC or any government agency/ department on the date of the submission of the bid till signing of the contract. In such case the bid shall not be accepted.

D. Amendment to bid document:

At any time prior to the date for submission of bids, the JKSPDC may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a request by a prospective bidder, modify the Bid Documents/ extend the deadline for the submission of bids by issuance of an Addendum/ Corrigendum, which shall be uploaded on the official website of **JKSPDC** and **www.Jktenders.gov.in**. Bidders are advised to visit the official website of JKSPDC and Jktenders.gov.in frequently till completion of the bidding process for the work.

E. Method of applying:

1. Interested bidders shall download the bid document from **www.jktenders.gov.in** from the date as specified in the e-NIT.
2. Interested bidders shall upload their "Bids" on **www.jktenders.gov.in** by or before last date of submission of the bid as specified in the e-NIT. No hard copies shall be required to be submitted by the bidder in response to the e-NIT. However, the bidder declared as L1 after opening of bids shall be required to submit the hard copy of his bid within 02 days from opening of the bid along with Bid
3. The bidders shall be declared qualified only upon uploading of all the requisite documents as laid down. Otherwise the bid will be liable for rejection.

F. Clarifications necessary for evaluation of bids:

JKSPDC may seek clarifications/ additional supporting documents from any or all the bidders which it may deem necessary for evaluation of the technical bids. The bidders shall be bound to furnish the clarifications/ additional supporting documents within 07 days of the request, failing which the bids of such bidders shall be rejected and shall not be considered for further evaluation. No post bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. Minor issues in the bid may be waived off by JKSPDC provided they do not constitute any material deviation as defined in the Manual for Procurement of Works 2019 issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance Govt.

G. Payment and certificate:

Contractor shall be entitled to progressive payments; however, 10% amount shall be retained as retention money/ bill deposit and same shall be released only after satisfactory completion of work and removal of defects if any and after conducting necessary repairs to the satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge and not earlier than completion of Defective Liability Period. In case of failure on part of contractor to remove defects or conduct repairs within stipulated period, the same shall be got removed or rectified by the Corporation on the risk and cost of the Contractor. In the event of the failure of JKSPDC to make payment within 60 (sixty) days of acceptance of Progressive Payment claim by the Engineer-in-Charge, the Contractor shall be entitled to receive simple interest on unpaid sum at the rate of 1% (one percent) per annum for the delayed payment.

H. Validity of bid:

The bid shall be valid for acceptance for a period of 180 days from the date of submission of bids. In exceptional circumstances JKSPDC may solicit the bidder's consent to an extension of the period of the validity. The request and the response there to shall be made in writing through letter/ or email. A bidder accepting the request will not be permitted to modify its bid.

I. Corrupt or fraudulent practices:

It is expected from the Bidders that they will observe the high standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such Contracts. For the purpose of this provision, the terms set-forth below shall mean as under:-

1. "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in Contract execution; and
2. "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract to the detriment of JKSPDC, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive JKSPDC of the benefits of free and open competition;
3. A bid may be rejected by JKSPDC if it is determined at any stage that respective bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract in question;

J. Force majeure:

In the event of either party being rendered unable by force-majeure to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under the Contract, the relative obligation of the party affected by such force majeure shall upon notification to the other party be suspended for the period during which the effect of the force majeure event lasts. The cost and loss sustained by either party shall be borne by the respective parties. The term 'Force Majeure' as employed herein shall mean an exceptional event or circumstance;

1. Which is beyond the control of the party alleging that it has been rendered unable.
2. which could not reasonably have been provided against before entering into the Contract by the party alleging so,

3. which, having arisen, could not have been overcome, by the said alleging party.

4. Which is not attributable to the other party.

Force majeure includes exceptional events or circumstances listed below, so long as conditions (1) to (4) above are satisfied:

- ❖ natural catastrophes such as earthquakes, hurricane, or volcanic activity,
- ❖ war (declared), invasion, or military or usurped power, act of foreign enemies,
- ❖ riot (other than among the Contractor's/its sub contractor's employees), civil commotion, civil war,

Upon the occurrence of any such cause, and upon its termination the party alleging that it has been rendered unable, as aforesaid, shall notify the other party in writing immediately but not later than 72 (seventy-two) hours about the alleged beginning and ending thereof. Within 21 days after ending of such occurrence a communication shall be given to the other party giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support thereof. Time for performance of the relative obligation suspended by the force majeure shall stand extended to the extent the effect of such occurrence affects the time for Completion.
