### DETAILED ONLINE OPEN COMPETITIVE BID (OCB) FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF "VOCATIONALISATION OF SECONDARY & HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION PROGRAMME" FOR 1275 GOVERNMENT SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS and 157 OUT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN TRAINING CENTERS (OoSC)

#### 1. Introduction:

- 1.1 Rajasthan Council of School Education, (hereinafter referred to as "RCSE") has implemented various projects at the Government Senior Secondary Schools level under the umbrella of 'Samagra Shiksha & STARS Project' to provide quality education to the students.
- 1.2 The scheme is operated within the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), which establishes a system of clear educational pathways from school to higher education while providing certification of vocational skills.
- 1.3 The vocationalisation of secondary & higher secondary program initiated in Rajasthan as a pilot in 2014-15. Till 2022-23, the program is being implemented in 1924 Govt. senior secondary schools.
- 1.4 RCSE (Rajasthan Council of School Education) invites qualified entities in the field of "Vocational Education Program in Government Senior Secondary Schools" to participate in an Online Open Competitive Bid. The objective of this bid is to select Skill Knowledge Facilitator Providers who will be responsible for providing 90 Skill Knowledge Facilitators for 1275 Government Schools (under the Samagra Shiksha scheme), and 157 Out of School Children training centres under STARS Project (herein after referred as "The Project").

#### 2. Scope of Work:

The implementation of the vocational education program will extend to all 33 districts of Rajasthan. This wide-ranging approach ensures that students across the state have access to vocational training opportunities, regardless of their geographic location. This program aims to provide opportunities to all government senior secondary school students i.e., regular students, Out of School Children, and CVSN students to equip themselves with the knowledge of vocational education and have opportunity for employment or to establish his/her own business.

The project will be executed in collaboration with selected Skill Knowledge Facilitators Providers (SKFPs). These SKFPs will be responsible for deploying skill knowledge facilitators who will facilitate the implementation of the vocational education program in the designated schools. The Skill Knowledge Facilitators (SKFs) will act as an integral part of the district and state offices, ensuring the successful implementation of the vocational education program in schools. They will be responsible for planning and finalizing the annual study plan, coordinating with relevant stakeholders, establishing valuable network connections, organizing informative industrial visits, facilitating practical on-the-job training and internships, identifying potential placement opportunities and providing necessary support to both schools and Skill Vocational trainers. Additionally, the SKFs will maintain regular communication with the district and state offices, keeping them informed about the progress and effective execution of the vocational education program in schools.

The vocational education program in Rajasthan will implement vocational education courses in the following sectors in 1275 Government senior secondary schools (under Samagra Shiksha) and 157 Out of School Children Training Centres- schools (under STARS project):

## 2.1. Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider (SKFP):

The Skill Knowledge Facilitator (SKFP) will be responsible for:-

- i. **Providing Skill Knowledge facilitators:**
  - a. The SKFPs are responsible for providing Skill Knowledge Facilitators and deploying them for schools to monitor and implement vocational education training program
  - b. The SKFP has to submit the verified documents related to the educational qualifications and experience of skill knowledge facilitators before the deployment and submit the same to the school, district, and state office.
  - c. The detailed role and responsibilities of Skill Knowledge Facilitator are attached with the bid document as annexure-F (after-schools list)
- ii. **Training and capacity Building:**
  - a. Provide comprehensive training to skill knowledge facilitators on their roles, responsibilities, and the implementation of the vocational education program.
  - b. To provide help to skill knowledge facilitators in designing and preparing the annual study plan and activity plan as per the time line.
  - c. To provide help to SKF in collaborating with the school head/principal and Kaushal Mitra to finalize the monthly, half-yearly and annual assessment pattern and schedule.
- iii. **Program Planning and Coordination:**
  - a. Through SKF Coordinate with school principals, vocational trainers, and Kaushal Mitra to ensure effective implementation of the study plan.
  - b. To facilitate the establishment of industry linkages and maintain a network of sector experts and artisans to support vocational education initiatives.
- iv. **Monitoring and Evaluation:**
  - a. To regularly monitor the performance of skill knowledge facilitators in assigned schools.
  - b. To conduct periodic assessments to evaluate the effectiveness of skill knowledge facilitators and their impact on student learning and outcomes.
  - c. To provide feedback and support to skill knowledge facilitators to address any challenges or gaps in their performance.
- v. **Reporting and Communication:**
  - a. To Collect and compile data, reports, and records from skill knowledge facilitators regarding student enrollment, assessment results, vocational activities, and industry linkages.

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- b. To communicate regularly with the state and district offices to provide updates on the progress and implementation of the vocational education program.
- c. Share best practices and success stories from skill knowledge facilitators to contribute to program improvement and replication and share the same with the district and state offices.
- vi. **Support and Guidance:**
  - a. To offer ongoing support and guidance to skill knowledge facilitators in their day-to-day activities.
  - b. To address any queries, concerns, or issues raised by skill knowledge facilitators and provide timely solutions and assistance.
- vii. **Leave Management and Monitoring of Skill Knowledge Facilitators:**  
At the district level, the authority for leave sanctioning and leave monitoring of Skill Knowledge Facilitators (SKFs) shall be vested in the District ADPC. An online attendance system for SKFs will be implemented, complete with geo-tagging and image-capture capabilities through a designated application. The specific application for this purpose will be provided by the Skill knowledge facilitator providers, as per the directions of RCScE State office.

## 2.2 Rajasthan Council of School Education (RCScE)

RCScE is the implementing organization and will be responsible for activities such as:-

- i. **Budgeting and expenditure** - Obtain and manage the MoE funding as per the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Vocationalization of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, and the State funds for the project implementation. Selection by the State Government is subjected to availability/approval /release of funds by the Central and State Government.
- ii. **Identification of districts/ schools** - The Selection of Districts / Schools/ Trade or Sector.
- iii. **Communication and marketing plan:** To create awareness, and stakeholder engagement, and bring in the right talent into the NSQF program. Counselling of students & parents to enroll in the program.
- iv. **Identification of Skill Knowledge Facilitators Providers:** The State Government will identify Skill Knowledge facilitator providers for schools/sectors through the selection process prescribed in the Online Open Competitive Bid issued by the RCScE for Academic Year 2023-24 & 2024-25.
- v. **Advisory Group:** To establish advisory/management groups at the various levels for monitoring/feedback/regular assessments process.
- vi. **Orientation of Skill knowledge Facilitators:** RCScE (Rajasthan Council of School Education) shall conduct the "Orientation of Skill Knowledge Facilitators" program at regular intervals with the help of district and state officials. The purpose of this program is to provide necessary updates on the developed content, training methodology, and alignment with industry requirements, as per the guidelines outlined in the scheme and the prescribed financial limitations.

**2.4. Project Site:** The project will be implemented in 1432 Government senior secondary schools (1275 schools under Samagra Shiksha and 157 Out of School Children Training Centres under the STARS project) across all 33 districts of Rajasthan. The list of schools is provided in EOI "ANNEXURE - E"

**2.5. Outsourcing to the third party:** The Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider shall provide a single point of contact (SPOC) with RCSE and shall be solely responsible for the execution and delivery of the work. The SKFPs shall not further outsource the work to a 3<sup>rd</sup> party including its franchisees/licensees.

**2.6. Time frame of EOI:** The EOI (Expression of Interest) is for two academic years, namely 2023-24 and 2024-25. For this EOI, the academic year 2023-24 shall commence from the date of deployment of Skill Knowledge Facilitator and shall extend until June 30th, 2024. Similarly, the academic year 2024-25 shall span from July 1, 2024, to April 30, 2025. It is of utmost importance to explicitly clarify that the academic years mentioned in this EOI, as well as in any subsequent agreement, shall be strictly interpreted and understood exclusively within the specified timeframes mentioned above.

### 3. Eligible Criteria:

#### 3.0 Pre Eligibility:

3.0.1 DD/BC of Rs. 5000 for bid document fees in favour of Rajasthan Council of School Education, Jaipur

3.0.2 DD/BC of Rs. 2500 for bid processing fees in favour of MD RSI Jaipur.

3.0.3 Bid Security – DD/BC/BG for EMD 2 % of Total bid value in favour of Rajasthan Council of School Education, Jaipur

All the above-mentioned DD/BC and Bid Security (DD/BC/BG) should be deposited by hand in the office of the State Project Director – Rajasthan Council of School Education Jaipur. Before last date and time of bid submission.

- 3.4 The Applicant should be compliant with and agree to the terms and conditions laid down in Annexure-05.
- 3.5 If selected, the Applicant should have an office in the state and submit the following to RCSE: -  
(1) Ownership / Rent Agreement

#### 4. Provisions for Payments:

- 4.1 Payment to Skill Knowledge Facilitator (SKF) by the Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider: The Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider (SKFP) is responsible for paying a gross honorarium of INR 25,000 per month to each Skill Knowledge Facilitator deployed. The SKFP must maintain transparent payment records and directly credit the honorarium to the SKFs' accounts through ECS, RTGS, or NEFT. A monthly copy of the payment details should be sent to the concerned district ADPC office.

Reimbursement will follow a decentralised approach, with the State office making payments to the districts and the districts subsequently making payments to the SKFPs. The SKFPs must submit a file at the district office, including documents such as Skill Knowledge Facilitator attendance, bank statements reflecting payments made, school visit verification by principal & district offices and other necessary documents. Before making payment to the Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider the district office will ensure the authenticity of the submitted documents.

The SKFPs shall release skill knowledge facilitator's honorarium for 03 consecutive months without fail, even in case payment is under process from RCSE side. In the situation of non-compliance the allotted schools of such Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider may be transferred to other Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider (SKFP) or other strict actions may be taken against such SKFP after the due approval of competent authorities.

- 4.2 Payment to SKFP by RCSE:

For the services being provided by the SKFP, RCSE shall pay to SKFP the following amounts:

- a) An amount equal to the honorarium paid by the SKFP to the SKFs as per clause 4.1 of Payments head.
- b) Successful bidder will be paid agency administrative charge as per financial bid, which will not be more than 12 percent of the honorarium being paid to all the SKFs to be deployed by him. This amount shall cover the cost of
  - i. Recruitment of SKFs.
  - ii. Management of SKFs, as leave reserve, appointing backup of SKFs (in case a SKF quits or takes long term leave) and
  - iii. Miscellaneous expenses for the handling of the Project
  - iv. Other activities as per the entire scope of work mentioned in 2.1.

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- c) The awareness activities, yearly plan and compliance report should be shared with RCScE as per the notification released by RCScE on timely basis.
- d) Evidence/proof of payment to SKF by SKFP shall be submitted for reimbursement to District Office along with bills.
- e) The SKFP shall submit invoices every month to RCScE (State/District Office) mentioning the name of the district in which original evidence of payment has been submitted by 15<sup>th</sup> day of the next [following] month which will include SKF honorarium, agency administrative charges along with NEFT/RTGS/ECS payment certificate of previous month.

**5. Last date for bid submission:**

Only signed (with seal & signature on all the pages) online open competitive bid Applications should be uploaded on EPROC before 18.00 hours IST on or before 02.12.23 i.e., application due date.

RCScE may, in exceptional circumstances, and at its sole discretion, extend the Application due Date by issuing an Addendum uniformly for all Applicants.

**6. Late Applications:**

Any Application received after the Application Due Date and time shall not be accepted by RCScE. Any such Application received after the Application Due Date shall be summarily rejected.

**7. Submission of Application:**

- 7.1 All applications shall be submitted online on EPROC and in separate technical and financial envelopes on the portal. Applications submitted either by hand, facsimile transmission or e-mail shall not be acceptable.
- 7.2 All the Applicants are entitled to submit one Application as an individual. In case an Applicant submits more than one Application in response to this Online Open Competitive Bid then all the applications submitted by the Applicant would be rejected.

**8. Shortlisting Process:**

- 8.1 The following selection process shall be adopted by RCScE.
- 8.2 The Applications received shall be scrutinised for completeness and fulfilment of minimum requirements for eligibility as detailed out elsewhere in this Online Open Competitive Bid.
- 8.3 A list of applicants who fulfil the minimum eligibility criterion shall be prepared and called as LIST-1
- 8.4 The applicants in LIST-1 shall be invited to participate in the financial round in front of the RCScE Selection Committee.
- 8.5 The financial bid will be opened only for those bidders who are successful as per the technical parameters defined in the bid and whose names appear in LIST-1
- 8.6 The bidder, who will quote the lowest price in the financial bid will be considered the L1 bidder.
- 8.7 Dividing quantities among more than one bidder at the time of the award: - As a general rule, all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted. Counter offer to the first lowest bidder (L1), in order to arrive at an acceptable price, shall amount to negotiation. However, any counter offers thereafter to the second lowest bidder (L2), third lowest bidder (L3), etc. (at the rates accepted by L1) in case of splitting of quantities, as pre-disclosed in the bidding documents, shall not be deemed to be a negotiation.
- 8.8 The selected SKFP shall enter into a written Agreement with RCScE within 7 days of the finalisation of the selection of the SKFPs by RCScE.

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- K.9** The Performance security deposit will be submitted to RCSCF before or at the time of the signing of the written agreement.
- K.10** As per RIPP rule 75-A "An additional performance security shall also be taken from the successful bidder in case of unbalance bid (when the quoted L1 rates are less than 15% of the estimated bid amount, the bid is considered to be unbalance bid). The additional performance security shall be equal to fifty percent of the Unbalanced Bid amount. The additional performance security shall be deposited as a lump sum by the successful bidder before execution of agreement".

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## Annexure 5

### Terms and Conditions

#### 1) Exclusion of Online Open Competitive Bid/ Disqualification

- a) RCScE shall exclude/ disqualify an Online Open Competitive Bid, if: -
  - i. the information submitted related to qualifications (eligibility criteria) of the applicant is false or constituted a misrepresentation
  - ii. the information submitted related to qualifications of the applicant is materially inaccurate or incomplete
  - iii. the applicant is not qualified as per pre-qualification/ eligibility criteria mentioned in the bidding document
  - iv. the Online Open Competitive Bid materially departs from the requirements specified in the bidding document
  - v. the applicant submitting the Online Open Competitive Bid, his agent or anyone acting on his behalf, gave or agreed to give, to any officer or employee of the RCScE or other governmental authority a gratification in any form or any other thing of value, so as to unduly influence the procurement process
  - vi. An applicant in the opinion of the RCScE has a conflict of interest materially affecting fair competition
  - vii. If Applicant do not submit the proposal only in the prescribed format and in sequencing order with index and proper page numbering.
- b) An Online Open Competitive Bid shall be excluded/ disqualified as soon as the cause for its exclusion/ disqualification is discovered.
- c) Every decision of a RCScE to exclude an Online Open Competitive Bid shall be for reasons to be recorded in writing and shall be: -
  - i. Communicated to the concerned applicant in writing.
  - ii. Published on the State Public Procurement Portal, if applicable.

#### 2) RCScE's right to accept or reject any or all Online Open Competitive Bid

The RCScE reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul (cancel) the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to the award of the contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the applicants.

The service provider makes no commitments, explicit or implicit, that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone

#### 3) Cancellation of the procurement process

- a) If any procurement process has been cancelled, it shall not be reopened but it shall not prevent the RCScE from initiating a new procurement process for the same subject matter of procurement if required.
- b) RCScE may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, cancel the process of Online Open Competitive Bid initiated by it:
  - i. At any time prior to the acceptance of the successful Online Open Competitive Bid; or
  - ii. After the successful Online Open Competitive Bid is accepted in accordance with (d) and (e) below.
- c) The decision of the RCScE to cancel the procurement and reasons for it shall be immediately communicated to all participant applicants in the Online Open Competitive Bid process.
- d) If the applicant who's Online Open Competitive Bid has been accepted as successful, fails to sign any written contract as required or fails to provide any required security for the performance of the contract, the RCScE may cancel the process.
- e) RCScE (Rajasthan Council of School Education) retains the authority to terminate the agreement with the Skill knowledge facilitator Providers (SKFPs) based on valid reasons by providing a one-month notice period. In case of agreement termination, the SKFPs' Bank Guarantee (BG) shall not be refunded, as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement.

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- f) If an applicant is convicted of any offence under the Act/Rules (to be specified by accounts department), the RCScE may: -
- Cancel the Online Open Competitive Bid of the convicted applicant who has been declared as successful, but no contract has been entered into.

#### 4) Code of Integrity for Applicants

- No person participating in the Online Open Competitive Bid process shall act in contravention of the code of integrity prescribed by the State Government.
- The code of integrity includes provisions for: -
  - Prohibiting
    - any offer, solicitation, or acceptance of any bribe, reward or gift, or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process;
    - any omission, including a misrepresentation that misleads or attempts to mislead so as to obtain a financial or other benefit or avoid an obligation;
    - any collusion, Online Open Competitive Bid rigging, or anti-competitive behaviour to impair the transparency, fairness, and progress of the procurement process;
    - improper use of information shared between the RCScE and the applicants with an intent to gain an unfair advantage in the procurement process or for personal gain;
    - any financial or business transactions between the applicant and any officer or employee of the RCScE;
    - any coercion including impairing or harming or threatening to do the same, directly or indirectly, to any party or to its property to influence the procurement process;
    - any obstruction of any investigation or audit of a procurement process;
  - disclosure of conflict of interest;
  - Disclosure by the applicant of any previous transgressions with any entry in India or any other country during the last three years or of any debarment by any other government department (Centre/State/Other State) or RCScE.
- Without prejudice to the provisions below, in case of any breach of the code of integrity by an applicant or prospective applicant, as the case may be, the RCScE may take appropriate measures including: -
  - exclusion of the applicant from the procurement process;
  - calling-off pre-contract negotiations;
  - forfeiture or encashment of any other security or bond relating to the procurement;
  - recovery of payments made by the RCScE along with interest thereon at bank rate;
  - cancellation of the relevant contract and recovery of compensation for loss incurred by the RCScE;
  - Debarment of the applicant from participation in future procurements of the RCScE for a period of three years.

#### 5) Interference with Procurement Process

An applicant, who: -

- Withdraws from the process after the opening of the Online Open Competitive Bid
- Withdraws from the process after being declared the successful applicant
- Fails to enter into a contract after being declared the successful applicant
- Fails to provide performance security or any other document or security required in terms of the bidding documents after being declared the successful applicant, without valid grounds shall, in addition to the recourse available in the bidding document or the contract, be punished with a fine which may extend to fifty lakh rupees or ten percent of the assessed value of procurement, whichever is less.
- As per RTTP act rule 75, (a) An additional performance security shall also be taken from the successful bidder in case of unbalanced bid when the quoted L1 rates are less than 15% of the estimated bid value, the bid is considered to

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be an unbalanced bid). The additional performance security shall be equal to fifty percent of the Unbalanced Bid amount. The additional performance security shall be deposited in a lump sum by the successful bidder before execution of the agreement.

## 6) Appeals

- a) Subject to "Appeal not to lie in certain cases" below, if any applicant or prospective applicant is aggrieved that any decision, action, or omission of the procuring entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the rules or guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to such officer of the RCScE, as may be designated by it for the purpose, within a period of 10 days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:
  - i. Provided that after the declaration of an applicant as successful in terms of "Award of Contract", the appeal may be filed only by an applicant who has participated in procurement proceedings;
  - ii. Provided further that in case RCScE evaluates the technical Online Open Competitive Bid before the opening of the financial Bid, an appeal related to the matter of financial Online Open Competitive Bid may be filed only by an applicant whose technical Online Open Competitive Bid is found to be acceptable.
- b) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under (a) above shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it off within 30 days from the date of filing of the appeal.
- c) If the officer designated under (a) above fails to dispose of the appeal filed under that sub-section within the period specified in (b) above, or if the applicant or prospective applicant or the RCScE is aggrieved by the order passed, the applicant or prospective applicant or the RCScE, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to an officer or authority designated by the State Government in this behalf within 15 days from the expiry of the period specified in (b) above or of the date of receipt of the order passed under (b) above, as the case may be.
- d) The officer or authority to which an appeal is filed under (c) above shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within 30 days from the date of filing of the appeal.
- e) The officer or authority to which an appeal may be filed under (a) or (d) above shall be First Appellate Authority: Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary / Secretary -School Education, GOR. Second Appellate Authority: Secretary Finance, GOR.
- f) Form of Appeal:
  - I. Every appeal under (a) and (c) above shall be as per Annexure-C along with as many copies as there are respondents in the appeal.
  - II. Every appeal shall be accompanied by an order appealed against, if any, an affidavit verifying the facts stated in the appeal, and proof of payment of the fee.
  - III. Every appeal may be presented to First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, in person or through a registered post or authorised representative.
- g) Fee for Appeal:
  - i. The fee for the first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for the second appeal shall be
  - ii.
  - III. rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable.
  - iv. The fee shall be paid in the form of a bank demand draft or banker's cheque of a Scheduled Bank payable in the name of the Appellate Authority concerned.
- h) Procedure for disposal of appeal:
  - i. The First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, upon the filing of the appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by a copy of the appeal, affidavit, and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix the date of hearing.
  - ii. On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, shall, -
    - a) hear all the parties to appeal, present before him; and
    - b) Peruse or inspect documents, relevant records, or copies thereof relating to the matter.

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- iii. After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the Appellate Authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and provide a copy of the order to the parties to appeal free of cost.
- iv. The order passed under (h) shall also be placed on the State Public Procurement Portal.
- v. No information which would impair the protection of essential security interests of India, or impede the enforcement of the law or fair competition, or prejudice the legitimate commercial interests of the applicant or the RCScE, shall be disclosed in a proceeding under an appeal.

#### 7) Stay of procurement proceedings

While hearing an appeal, the officer or authority hearing the appeal may, on an application made on this behalf and after giving the parties involved a reasonable opportunity to be heard, stay the procurement proceedings pending disposition of the appeal if he or she is satisfied that failure to do so will result in a perversion of justice.

#### 8) Vexatious Appeals & Complaints

Whoever intentionally files any vexatious, frivolous, or malicious appeal or complaint with the intention of delaying or defeating any procurement or causing loss to any RCScE or any other applicant, shall be punished with a fine which may extend to twenty lakh rupees or five percent of the value of procurement, whichever is less.

#### 9) Offences by Firms/ Companies

- a) Where an offence has been committed by a company, every person who at the time the offence was committed was in charge of and was responsible to the company for the conduct of the business of the company, as well as the company, shall be deemed to be guilty of having committed the offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly:  
Provided that nothing contained in this sub-section shall render any such person liable for any punishment if he proves that the offence was committed without his knowledge or that he had exercised all due diligence to prevent the commission of the such offence
- b) Notwithstanding anything contained in (a) above, where an offence under Act/Rules has been committed by a company and it is proved that the offence has been committed with the consent or connivance of or is attributable to any neglect on the part of any director, manager, secretary or other officers of the company, such director, manager, secretary or other officers shall also be deemed to be guilty of having committed such offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.
- c) For the purpose of this section-
  - i. "company" means a body corporate and includes a limited liability partnership, firm, registered society or co-operative society, trust or other association of individuals; and
  - ii. "Director" in a relation to a limited liability partnership or firm, means a partner in the firm.
- d) Abetment of certain offenses: Whoever abets an offence punishable under this Act, whether or not that offence is committed in consequence of that abetment, shall be punished with the punishment provided for the offence

#### 10) Debarment from submission of Online Open Competitive Bid/ Bidding

- a) An applicant shall be debarred by the State Government if he has been convicted of an offence
  - i. under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 49 of 1988); or
  - ii. under the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Central Act No. 45 of 1860) or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of the execution of a public procurement contract.
- b) An applicant debarred under (a) above shall not be eligible to participate in a procurement process of any RCScE for a period of three years commencing from the date on which he was debarred.



- c) If RCScE finds that an applicant has breached the code of integrity prescribed in terms of the "Code of Integrity for applicants" above, it may debar the applicant for a period of three years.
- d) Where the entire performance security or any substitute thereof, as the case may be, of an applicant has been forfeited by RCScE in respect of any procurement process or procurement contract, the applicant may be debarred from participating in any procurement process undertaken by the RCScE for a period of three years.
- e) The State Government or RCScE, as the case may be, shall not debar an applicant under this section unless such applicant has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard.

### 11) Penalty Clause

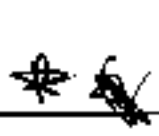
- a. The penalty of Rs. 500 per day per skill knowledge facilitator in case of delay in the initial joining of trainers deployed by SKFP beyond the specified time period (specified in MOU). In any case the delay should not be more than of 15 calendar days. But in case of unavoidable circumstances the SKFP shall submit the application of relaxation, on which the decision of RCScE shall prevail.
- b. At the district level, the authority for leave sanctioning and leave monitoring of Skill Knowledge Facilitators (SKFs) shall be vested in the District ADPC. An online attendance system for SKFs will be implemented, complete with geo-tagging and image-capture capabilities through a designated application. The specific application for this purpose will be provided by the Skill Knowledge Facilitator providers, as per the directions of RCScE State office.
- c. The skill knowledge facilitator is permitted to take one leave per month, and any unused leaves can be accumulated throughout the academic year. However, the maximum number of leaves that can be availed in an academic year is 12. In the event that the skill knowledge facilitator exceeds the limit of 12 leaves in a year, a penalty of Rs. 500 will be imposed on the skill knowledge facilitator Provider (SKFP). Additionally, for each day of leave beyond the allowable limit, the skill knowledge facilitator will not receive remuneration for that day.
- d. In case of absence of skill knowledge facilitator without intimation the SKFP will be penalized for Rs. 500 per day per skill knowledge facilitator and the remuneration for the day to skill knowledge facilitator will not be paid. If the absence is for more than 5 days the SKFP shall arrange the full-time substitute skill knowledge facilitator otherwise the penalty charges will be doubled.
- e. In case the skill knowledge facilitator provider is unable to arrange the substitute (full time skill knowledge facilitator) within three working days (5+3=8) then the services provided by the SKFP deemed to be unsatisfactory and a show cause notice should be issued to skill knowledge facilitator provider. The SKFP has to reply within three days of the issuance of the notice. In case the skill knowledge facilitator provider does not reply within three calendar days or skill knowledge facilitator providers' reply is not found satisfactory by RCScE, then RCScE will consider this as a case of dissatisfactory service. The RCScE then can initiate action against SKFP.
- f. Industrial Visit and On Job Training (OJT) not conducted due to negligence of SKF then a penalty amounting to Rs. 100 per student shall be applicable.
- g. In case of breach/violation of any MOE norms and other guidelines, the RCScE reserves the decision on levying appropriate penalties in cases other than those mentioned from clauses (a) to (e).

#### Note:

- i. Fraction of a day in the reckoning period of delay in supplies shall be eliminated if it is less than half a day.
- ii. If the skill knowledge facilitator provider requires an extension of time in completion of contractual supply on account of the occurrence of any hindrances, he shall apply in writing to the authority issuing the supply order, for the same immediately on the occurrence of the hindrance but not after the stipulated date of completion of supply.

### 12) Other Terms

- a. In case any applicant refuses to sign an agreement with RCScE after school allotment, in such circumstances RCScE will forfeit the bid security submitted by the applicant as per RPP Rules, 2013.



- b. Performance Security Deposit:- Whereas the approved SKFP has deposited with the Rajasthan Council of School Education a sum of Rs. ... (5% according to RTPP Act of total amount of LOA issued) as security deposit for the due and faithful performance of the agreement, it shall be forfeited in the event of supplier not performing his duties as per terms of the agreement. DD/bankers cheque/Bank Guarantee in the name of Rajasthan Council of School Education Jaipur to be submitted. If desired, the selected applicant can adjust the amount of bid security in the performance security deposit amount.
- c. SKFP should have a registered office in Rajasthan.
- d. The EOI (Expression of Interest) is for two academic years, namely 2023-24 and 2024-25. For this EOI, the academic year 2023-24 shall commence from the date of deployment of Skill Knowledge Facilitator and shall extend until June 30th, 2024. Similarly, the academic year 2024-25 shall span from July 1, 2024, to April 30, 2025. It is of utmost importance to explicitly clarify that the academic years mentioned in this EOI, as well as in any subsequent agreement, shall be strictly interpreted and understood exclusively within the specified timeframes mentioned above.
- e. Skill knowledge facilitator notwithstanding the penalty terms in case SKFP does not put into place the skill knowledge facilitator for more than 15 calendar days from the originally stipulated date then the school may be allotted to another SKFP.
- f. Any SKFP who like to discontinue CSS for VSHSE program during the period of the signed agreement with RCScE then the SKFP shall inform about it in writing three months in advance before ending the agreement. However, such SKFP will not be eligible to participate in the Online Open Competitive Bid for the next three forthcoming years. The RCScE will allot the concerned schools to other SKFPs. In such circumstances, the BG submitted by SKFP will be forfeited.
- g. RCScE (Rajasthan Council of School Education) retains the authority to terminate the agreement with the Skill knowledge facilitator providers (SKFPs) based on valid reasons by providing a one-month notice period. In case of agreement termination, the SKFPs' Bank Guarantee (BG) shall not be refunded, as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement.
- h. If any applicant breaches the agreement during the tenure period, RCScE reserves the right to take any of the following actions: (a) Forfeiting of the Performance Security, (b) Distribution of allotted schools to other SKFPs, (c) Taking appropriate legal action/lodging of FIR against the firm (d) Debarment of the SKFPs.
- i. Always ensure compliance with the circular of राजस्थान सरकार शिक्षा (अ-3) विभाग, जयपुर फ-2(1) किल/ए सीएफ/2017-जयपुर, दिनांक 30/04/2013- संख्या 1/2018
- j. The RCScE reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of vocational education schools to be allotted.
- k. The SKFP shall always ensure compliance with all guidelines and circulars etc. being issued from time to time by the State Government/ RCScE for implementation of the scheme.
- l. The vocational education agreement for CSS-VHSE will initially be for two academic years. MoU can be further extended to one more year after the mutual consent of both parties.
- m. All other terms and conditions of the Online Open Competitive Bid will adhere to Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 and Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013, and General Finance and Accounts Rules.
- n. The bidder should not leave any column blank in the financial bid document. If the bidder does not wish to apply for a trade/sector then NA should be written in that column.
- o. For uploading an online bid document, the digital signature of the bidder is mandatory. All bidders should procure digital signatures timely. In case any bidder is not able to submit a bid due to an internet connectivity issue, in such case the Rajasthan Council of School Education, Jaipur will not be held liable.
- p. The bid will be valid for 90 days.
- q. L1 bidder shall be decided independently and the lowest bidder shall be the L1 bidder for procurement of services.
- r. TDS will be deducted only on administration/agency charges as per IT rule.
- s. The SKFPs have to do the job placement tracking for 12 months for the 12th pass-out students of previous years. The relevant data of these students will be made available to the school & district authorities by SKFP. A quarterly report related to it will be submitted by SKFP to RCScE Jaipur.
- t. The remuneration shall be paid to the skill knowledge facilitator on monthly basis regularly by the SKFPs. The SKFP shall release SKF honorarium for 03 consecutive months without fail, even in case payment is under process from the RCScE side. In the case of non-compliance to terms of EOI, RCScE reserves the right to transfer the allotted schools of such SKFP to another training provider, or any other appropriate action may be taken against such service provider (as mentioned in Other Terms Point no. h).

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- u. In order to be deployed as a skill knowledge facilitator for state government English Medium schools (existing or future) the SKF should have fluency in the English language along with excellent written and oral communication skills.
- v. If selected SKFPs are offered schools under the HUB & Spoke model then according to RCSE guidelines, they must carry out the regular activities in the assigned schools through their skill knowledge facilitator.
- w. The performance of the Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider (SKFP) shall be assessed on an annual basis. The RCSE (Rajasthan Council of School Education) will decide the performance appraisal process. The performance appraisal will be done on the basis of the assessment and evaluation of the services provided by the skill knowledge facilitator. The purpose of this performance appraisal is to ensure adherence to the agreed-upon standards and guidelines. The contract between the parties may be terminated, if the SKFP fails to meet the required standards.

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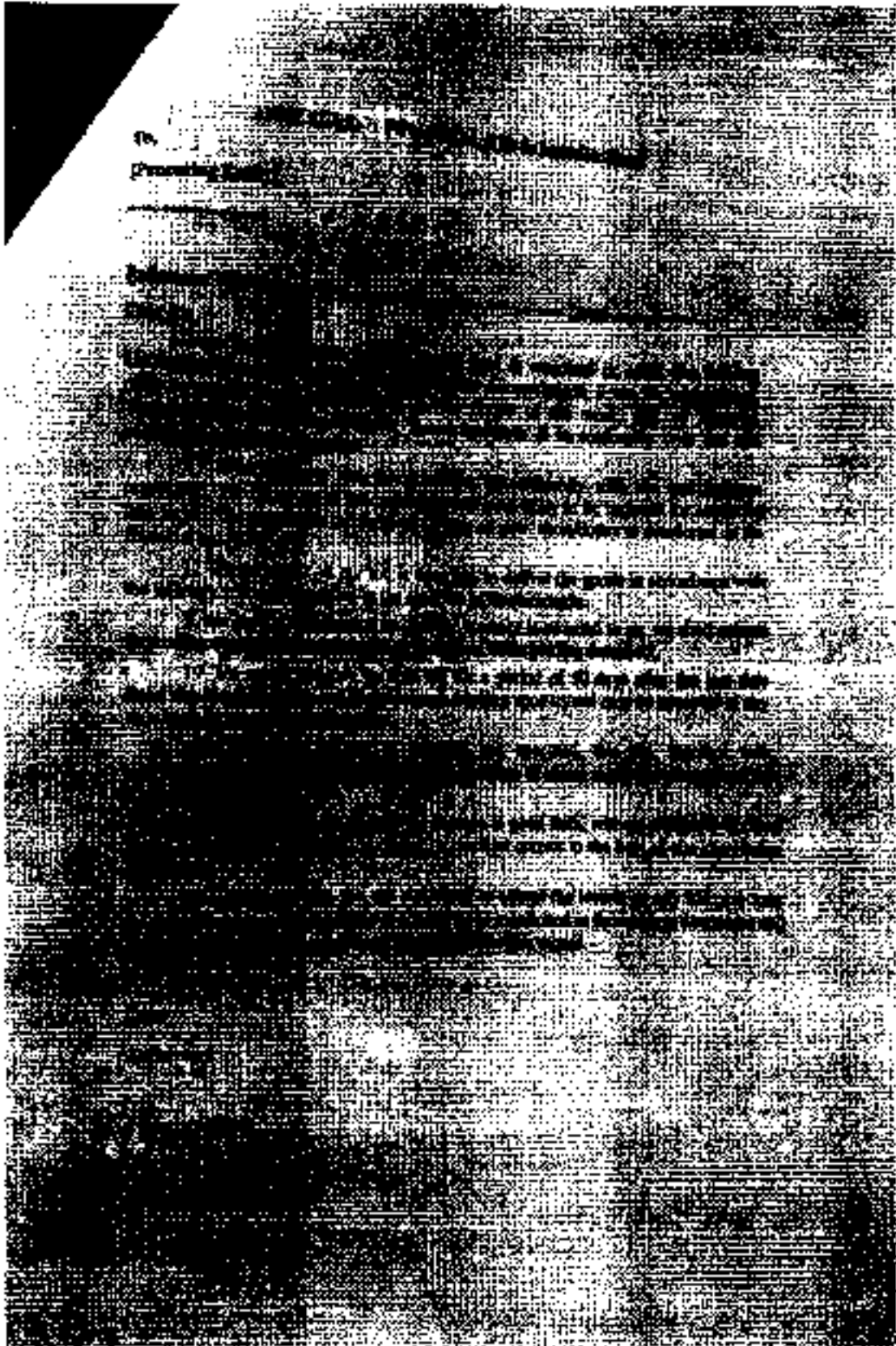

### (iii) Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action, or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules of the Guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document; within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or ground on which, he feels aggrieved:-

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a procuring entity evaluates the technical bids before the opening of the financial bids, an appeal related to the matter of financial bids may be filed only by a bidder whose technical bid is found to be acceptable.

The Officer to whom an appeal is filed under Para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavor to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.

- (iv) If the officer designated under Para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in Para (2), or if the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the first appellate authority, the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to the second appellate authority specified in the bidding document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in Para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the first appellate authority, as the case may be.

## Annexure D

### Additional Condition of Contract

#### **1. Correction of arithmetic errors:**

Provided that a financial bid is substantially responsive, the procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during the evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis:

- (i) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- (ii) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and.
- (iii) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to clauses (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its Bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be Executed.

#### **2. Procuring entity's right to vary quantity/units:**

- (i) The units originally indicated in the bidding document may vary without any change in the unit prices and other terms and conditions of the bid and the conditions of the contract
- (ii) If the RCSCE gives a work order less than the quantity indicated in the bidding documents the bidder shall not be entitled to any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the conditions of the contract
- (iii) If the Bidder fails to deliver, the RCSCE shall be free to arrange/procure the Item's services and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the Service Provider

#### **2. Dividing quantities among more than one bidder:**

As a general rule, all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the bidder, whose bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted. Counter offer to the first lowest bidder (L1), in order to arrive at an acceptable price, shall amount to negotiation. However, any counter offers thereafter to the second lowest bidder (L2), third lowest bidder (L3), etc. (at the rates accepted by L1) in case of splitting of quantities, as pre-disclosed in the bidding documents, shall not be deemed to be a negotiation.

2. Whereas the approved Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider (SKFP) has agreed with the Government to implement the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Vocationalization of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (CSS for VSHSE) of Vocational Education Programme in Government Senior Secondary Schools as mentioned in Table 1 below in Rajasthan for the Academic year 2023-24 & 2024-25 (as mentioned in clause 2.5 Time Frame of EOI). Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider shall also abide by all articles set forth in the schedule appended hereto in the manner set forth in the conditions of the Online Open Competitive Bid (OCB) and contract appended herewith and at the rates set forth in column 'Quoted Amount/Evaluated Amount in ₹' of the OCB schedule. The details of the number of schools with trades and their rates per school are as follows, and the name/particulars of the allotted school are annexed as Annexure 1;

- The conditions of the bid document and contract for the open competitive bid enclosed to the bid Notice No (UBN No. .... dated ....) and also appended to this agreement will be deemed to be taken as part of this agreement and are binding on the parties executing this agreement
- Letters Nos. .... (Email dates received for accepting L1 rates) received from bidders and letters Nos. .... (Specific letter no. sent to each successful L1 bidder) issued by the RCSE and appended to this agreement shall also form part of this agreement.
- The RCSE do hereby agree that if the Skill knowledge facilitator provider shall do needful action to implement Vocational Education Programme in Government Senior Secondary Schools as mentioned in Table 1 above in Rajasthan for the Academic year 2023-24 & 2024-25 for vocational education in manner aforesaid observe and abide by the said terms and conditions, the RCSE (state/district level) will reimburse the amount of honorarium and administrative charges through NEFT/RTGS/ECS or any other manner to the Skill knowledge facilitator provider at the time and the manner set forth in the said conditions, the amount payable for each and every consignment as per terms mentioned in the bid document.



5. The skill knowledge facilitators will be deployed for the Government Senior Secondary Schools as mentioned in Table No. 1 across all the districts of Rajasthan for the Academic year 2023-24 & 2024-25. The agreement will be effective and completed as per the bid documents and agreement terms within the period up to the end of the Academic Session 2023-24 & 2024-25. The RCScE reserves the right to extend for another Academic Year with the mutual consent of both parties

#### 6. Penalty Clause

- The penalty of Rs. 500 per day per skill knowledge facilitator in case of delay in the initial joining of trainers deployed by SKFP beyond the specified time period (specified in MoU). In any case the delay should not be more than of 15 calendar days. But in case of unavoidable circumstances the SKFP shall submit the application of relaxation, on which the decision of RCScE shall prevail.
- The skill knowledge facilitator is permitted to take one leave per month, and any unused leaves can be accumulated throughout the academic year. However, the maximum number of leaves that can be availed in an academic year is 12. In the event that the skill knowledge facilitator exceeds the limit of 12 leaves in a year, a penalty of Rs. 500 will be imposed on the skill knowledge facilitator Provider (SKFP). Additionally, for each day of leave beyond the allowable limit, the skill knowledge facilitator will not receive remuneration for that day.
- In case of absence of skill knowledge facilitator without intimation the SKFP will be penalized for Rs. 500 per day per skill knowledge facilitator and the remuneration for the day to skill knowledge facilitator will not be paid. If the absence is for more than 5 days the SKFP shall arrange the full-time substitute skill knowledge facilitator otherwise the penalty charges will be doubled.
- In case the skill knowledge facilitator provider is unable to arrange the substitute (full time skill knowledge facilitator) within three working days (5\*3=B) then the services provided by the SKFP deemed to be unsatisfactory and a show cause notice should be issued to skill knowledge facilitator provider. The SKFP has to reply within three days of the issuance of the notice. In case the skill knowledge facilitator provider does not reply within three calendar days or skill knowledge facilitator providers' reply is not found satisfactory by RCScE, then RCScE will consider this as a case of dissatisfactory service. The RCScE then can initiate action against SKFP.
- Industrial Visit and On Job Training (OJT) not conducted due to negligence of SKFP then a penalty amounting to Rs. 100 per student shall be applicable.
- In case of breach/violation of any MOE norms and other guidelines, the RCScE reserves the decision on levying appropriate penalties in cases other than those mentioned from clauses (a) to (e).

#### Note:

- The fraction of a day in the reckoning period of delay in supplies shall be eliminated if it is less than half a day.
  - If the Skill knowledge facilitator provider requires an extension of time in completion of contractual supply on account of the occurrence of any hindrances, he shall apply in writing to the authority issuing the supply order, for the same immediately on the occurrence of the hindrance but not after the stipulated date of completion of supply.
7. The Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider shall pay a gross honorarium to each Skill knowledge facilitator deployed for the selected schools as per the amount decided by RCScE. The remuneration shall be paid to Skill knowledge facilitator on monthly basis regularly by the SKFPs. The SKFP shall release Skill knowledge facilitator honorarium for 03 consecutive months without fail, even in case payment is under process from the RCScE side. In the situation of non-compliance the allotted schools of such SKFP may be transferred to another service provider or other strict actions may be taken against such service provider after the due approval from competent authorities. The payment details would have to be kept and maintained in a transparent manner by the Skill knowledge facilitator provider and will directly credit the honorarium to the SKFPs account through ECS/RTGS/NEFT and send the copy of the same on monthly basis to RCScE as directed by the authority. After payment of the above-mentioned honorarium, the invoices for reimbursement of the honorarium must be produced before the RCScE within three months of the corresponding month along with evidence of payment.

If any Skill knowledge facilitator provider fails to make payment as stipulated above then services provided by SKFP shall be treated as dissatisfactory and RCScE may initiate proceedings against such SKFPs as per rules in accordance to annexure 5, (terms & conditions) point no.12, sub-point h.

8. The agreement may be renewed as per the rules.
9. All disputes arising out of this agreement (extended) and all questions relating to the interpretation of this agreement shall be decided by the RCScE and the decision of the Executive Committee of the RCScE shall be final. In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be at Jaipur (Rajasthan) only.
10. Bill of reimbursement of the Skill knowledge facilitator's honorarium and administrative charges will be submitted to RCScE (state/district level) by Skill Knowledge Facilitator Provider.

## Annexure - F

### Role & Responsibilities of Skill Knowledge Facilitator

The Skill Knowledge Facilitator (SKF) is responsible for enhancing the planning and supervision of vocational education delivery, establishing industry relationships, and overseeing vocational education within schools. Moreover, the SKF is accountable for executing duties as assigned by the RCSEd. As a part of their role, the SKF is expected to visit all the allotted schools once in a month.

#### 1. Planning of vocational education activities:

- i. **Finalizing the study plan:** SKF in coordination with the School principal, vocational trainer, and Kaushal Mitra will assess the period required to complete the course and curriculum of the sector and the available periods then finalize the study plan theory & practical hours to be designated, time of schedule of all activities of vocational education i.e., industrial visit, CTF, skill competition to be defined clearly in the monthly & annual study plan. SKF will also help vocational trainer & Kaushal Mitra in finalizing the lesson plan for the year. In the 1<sup>st</sup> week of the first month of academic session for the existing and new schools after induction or in-service training.
- ii. **Planning assessment schedule for vocational education:** SKF will collaborate with the school head/principal and Kaushal Mitra to finalize the monthly, and half-yearly assessment pattern and schedule. In the first month of the academic year after induction or in-service training.
- iii. **Establishing industry linkages:** It is the responsibility of the SKF to identify and establish linkage with local industries, to facilitate activities like industrial visits, and On Job training /internship of vocational education students. Make a pool of Industries. The activity will start in the first month of the academic year and will be concluded in the next month after induction or in-service training.
- iv. **Identify local artisans/Sector experts:** SKF will explore the region and will identify local experts and artisans according to the theme of the activity. To facilitate the activity "exposure to vocational education", SKF has to identify artisans from engineering, energy and environment, agriculture, health etc sectors. SKF will make a pool of sector experts and get approval from the concerned school principal for the same. The activity will start in the first month of the academic year and will be concluded in the next month after induction training.
- v. **Facilitating sessions for students and parents:** SKF is responsible for planning & making arrangements for the counselling session for vocational students and parents as per the need (one-to-one or group).

#### 2. Execution of planned vocational education activities:

**Implementation of the planned activities effectively and efficiently:** It is the responsibility of the vocational coordinator, to make sure that the planned vocational activities and programs are carried out as per the curriculum and study plan in an effective and efficient manner. This involves sticking to timelines and schedules and maintaining the records of outputs, achievements, & overcome the bottlenecks in the vocational education plan.



At

- a. **Coordinating with relevant stakeholders:** It is the responsibility of the SKF to coordinate with vocational trainers, Kaushal Mitra, school principal, CBEO and ADPC on a regular basis to execute the activities as per the curriculum and study plan. SKF will meet with ADPC at least once in a month and will update about the ongoing vocational education activities. SKF will also meet CBEO once in each quarter.
- b. **Maintaining a pool of resource persons and industry networks:** The Skill Knowledge Facilitator (SKF) will maintain a pool of resource persons and local artisans at block and district levels. SKF will make sure that the schools are utilizing the resource pool. Additionally, they should also establish local industry networks at the block and district levels to facilitate OIT visits and job fairs.
- c. **Taking sessions for students and parents:** SKF will be making arrangements for the career counselling session for vocational students and parents as per the need (one to one or group). SKF will attend at least one SDMC and one parent teacher meeting to know the outcomes and student progress from the parents.
- d. **Meeting with district officials:** SKF must visit the district office once a month to submit the school plan, monthly progress, compliance reports, and other required reports in the meeting with ADPC, APL (VE), and PO (VE).

### 3. Monitoring of the Activities:

- a. **Regular monitoring and maintaining records of the vocational education program:** SKF is responsible for monitoring the progress and implementation of all vocational education activities. SKF will visit all allotted schools (Regular Samagra, Spoke, OoSC, and CWSN) once in each month and prepare all necessary records & reports i.e., student enrolment, assessment data, VT attendance, activity wise status & outcomes etc. and share the same with district and state office.
- b. **Gathering feedback:** The SKF should interact with all the stakeholders i.e., students, principals, Kaushal Mitra, vocational trainers, and parents to collect feedback on the vocational education program. SKF will be responsible for filling exit survey forms, he/she will fill the form after discussion with students.
- c. **Quarterly meeting with the State Office:** SKF will visit the state office each quarter to submit all the records and proposed plans for upcoming activities. (As per the instructions of the State office).
- d. **Facilitating continuous improvement:** SKF must contribute to the continuous improvement of all aspects of the vocational education program in the allocated schools.

- e. **Identification of the best practices:** SKF will submit report on the best practices of each school (Regular Samagra, Spoke, CoSC, and CWSN) twice in an academic year to the district and State office

The SKF will perform all the above activities in terms of regular vocational schools, spoke schools, CWSN, and vocational education for CoSC as and when required.
